

## Ideal Transportation Infrastructure

Gyeonggi Province has been constructing transportation infrastructure that connects the Seoul metropolitan area within one hour travel time via 2 international airports in Incheon and Gimpo, 2 international ports in Pyeongtaek and Incheon, 19 highways and 8 railways, In particular, when the construction of GTX (Great Train Express) is completed, we will achieve a green transportation revolution, connecting Seoul and major cities in Gyeonggi Province within a travel time of 30 minutes, This is possible because the GTX runs on tracks 40 meters underground at 100 km/h, a speed three times faster than the existing subway system.


